

Proud of our past & confident in our future!

Fort Gibson Lake lies in the hills of eastern Oklahoma. In the spring, timbered hills offer the sightseer the beauty of redbud, sand plum, dogwood, and haws blossoms. In the fall, the colorful foliage of hickory, oak, red maple, black gum, and woodbine sets the hills aglow.

Fish species include black bass, white bass, crappie, and several varieties of catfish and panfish. Fort Gibson Public Hunting Area, on the lake near Wagoner, covers 21,798 acres, with 3,500 acres devoted to a waterfowl refuge. Hunters will find game species such as whitetail deer, bobwhite quail, mourning dove, waterfowl, geese, cottontail rabbit, squirrel, and prairie chicken.

Facilities include boat ramps, picnic areas, six Class A campgrounds for RV and tent camping, full electric hookups, drinking water, group shelters, restrooms, showers, swimming beaches, six marinas, an enclosed fishing dock, and concession services. The lake offers 19,990 surface acres and 225 miles of shoreline.



You can take the open chute for a winding ride down or the enclosed tube for a faster shot at hitting the water. For the youngest water enthusiast, there is a unique kiddie pool where children may wade in the water and get acquainted with our new water features. There is also a raindrop umbrella in the main pool. Come beat the heat this summer and make memories that will last a lifetime. Lifeguards on duty and concessions are available.

The city becomes alive with thousands of beautiful lights and displays during the holiday season. Our Annual Christmas Parade of Lights and Characters attracts families from all over Green Country. The Wagoner City Public Library and civic groups make activities for families a priority, especially in the summer months.

Wagoner has an excellent education system, and the City of Wagoner has a strong relationship and partnership with our school district. In 2023, our graduating class received 3.9 million dollars in scholarships for their excellence in academics and athletics. In 2022, our Wagoner High Bulldog football team took home their 6th State Championship title in 12 years in 4A. Students at Wagoner can participate in various extracurricular activities such as Agriculture, Academic Team, Band, Drama, Golf, Track, Tennis, Baseball, Softball, Football, Cheerleading, Basketball, and more.

How to Get a Library Card:

You will be required to bring in a valid Oklahoma photo ID or Driver's License AND a current Utility Bill with YOUR NAME on it for residency authentication. Accepted Utility Bills include: Electric Bill, Water Bill, Internet, Cable, Gas, Trash and Landline Phone. Persons living outside Wagoner County will also be required to bring in the same Identification and residency authentication as listed above and charged a small fee.

Maple Park

Maple Park is a 55-acre-park located at the corner of NE 2nd St. and Story Ave. The park offers a number of amenities for Wagoner's citizens. It is the location of most of the youth recreation facilities including, soccer, baseball, and soccer fields. It is also the location for the high school football field and track. Maple Park is also home to a sand volleyball court, US-Open style tennis courts. Additional amenities include a large duck pond in the northeast section of the park equipped with a fishing pier and a number of pavilions and gazebos that can be utilized for family gatherings and other events.

Redbud Park

Redbud Park is located at SW 9th St. and Johnson Ave. This park is home to a large softball field that hosts league games and tournaments throughout the summer months.

Dunbar Park (In process of being developed)

Dunbar Park is a 10-acre-park located at W Cherokee St. and Lincoln Ave. The park's current use is an open space park. Swings are available. The space is an excellent place for people to gather and play fun field games throughout the park. It is currently the location for the annual tractor show.

Semore Park

Wagoner's keystone downtown park is located on the corner of Cherokee St. and Main St. This park is utilized throughout the entire year for the annual Christmas celebration. Its location offers an urban park setting that can be used for out of the office business meetings and an alternative place to meet for lunch.

South Courts/ Lincoln Park







